This seminar will provide a forum to address some of the issues relating to recent medico-legal concerns in Malaysia and Singapore.

The speakers from Singapore are Ms Nirmala Ravindran and Mr Edmund Kronenburg who are Advocates and Solicitors at the Singapore Bar and Mr Jeffrey Chan, S.C who is the former Deputy Solicitor-General at the Attorney General's Chambers in Singapore and is now the Principal State Counsel. They will be speaking on medical negligence in Singapore with a focus on the impact of the recent decision in *Montgomery v Lanarkshire Health Board [2015] UKSC 11*, pre-action protocols, alternative dispute resolution and expert testimony in medical disputes.

For the Malaysian segment, the speakers include Darryl SC Goon, Ms Sharon Palani and Raja Eileen Soraya who are all Advocates and Solicitors of the High Court of Malaya whose practice areas involve medical related matters.
